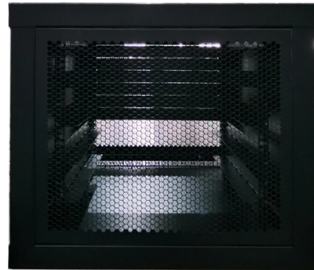

Connecting Your Fiber to a Router Install the ONT: Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port and power it on. Link ONT to Router: Use a Cat5e or higher Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power Up: Turn on the ONT first, then the router. Wait for status lights to stabilize. Configure Router: Access the router's admin panel to set up DHCP or PPPoE credentials, Wi-Fi name, password, and security settings (WPA3 recommended). Test Connection: Verify internet access and run a speed test to ensure the 10Mbps connection is active. Tips for Optimal Performance Use quality Ethernet cables (Cat5e or Cat6) to avoid bottlenecks. Position the router centrally for better Wi-Fi coverage. Avoid bending fiber cables excessively; maintain the recommended bend radius to prevent signal loss.
