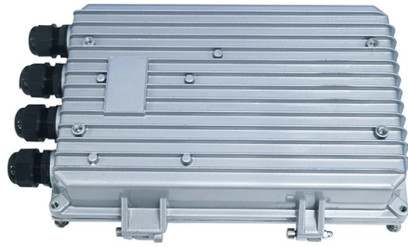


Access Switch Loop Prevention



Overview

STP prevents loops by blocking redundant paths, but misconfigurations or STP timer changes can cause loops to reform unexpectedly. Our existing design is quite simple, it consists of several switches acting as layer 2 (around 6-7) and all of them are connected to a switch through single interface trunk ports. This switch is connected to a firewall which is the gateway for all VLANS defined, which are extended in all the.
