

# Add shielding inside the cable tray



## Overview

Placing a layer of foil or braided metal between the tray cable's jacket and conductors substantially reduces EMI effects. The shielding, through its natural electrical properties, attracts, collects, and effectively (when properly grounded) drains off the EMI. This layer is called shielding. Its purpose is to collect and drain off electromagnetic interference (EMI) and radio frequency interference (RFI) caused by common mode currents. How Does EMI Affect Cables?

In layman's terms, a shielded tray cable is a type of electrical cable developed for installations with moderate to high ambient EMI (Electromagnetic Interference).
