

Are there electrical wires under the household electrical distribution box



Overview

Behind the cover plate surrounding all the panel's switches, you'll find three large wires entering the box from the main power line and many smaller wires that connect individual circuit breakers to electrical cables that run to different circuits throughout your house. Electricity arrives at your house from your local utility company by a power line or underground through a conduit. Most homes have three-wire service—two hot wires and one neutral. Electrical utilities deliver electricity through a masthead at the roof. Wires. The main electrical panel, commonly called the breaker box, is the central distribution point for all power inside the home. Standard household circuits operate at 120 volts by drawing. Once the conduit enters the basement does it need to immediately enter a box like this diagram or can I just continue the wire to outlet box 20' away. Is this a service wire (first off the meter), a feeder (going to a subpanel), or a simple circuit like for an EVSE or welder or receptacle?

A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
