- Cable Preparation:** Select cables rated for hazardous areas with EX or ATEX markings, resistant to flame, impact, and mechanical damage.
- Connect Cables:** Insert cables through the cable glands and connect them to the terminal blocks. Ensure internal and external grounding wires are properly connected.
- Seal the Enclosure:** Close the cover, secure it with fasteners, and tighten nuts to maintain the explosion-proof seal. Avoid scratching joint surfaces, and apply anti-rust oil if necessary.
- Check Installation Angle:** Ensure the box is installed with an inclination of no more than 5 degrees to maintain safety and functionality.
- Environmental Protection:** If installed outdoors, fit a rain cover and place the box away from heat sources, collision risks, and areas prone to corrosion or moisture.
- Maintenance and Safety Tips**
 - Do not open the cover while the power is on.
