

Building a three-level distribution box



AI Overview

A three-level distribution box system organizes power distribution hierarchically, with a main distribution box, secondary distribution boxes, and tertiary switch boxes to ensure safe, efficient, and controlled electricity delivery.

Overview of the Three-Level System

A three-level distribution system is designed to distribute electrical power from the main supply to end-use equipment in a structured and safe manner. It consists of:

- First-Level Distribution Box (Main Distribution Box):** Installed near the power source, it acts as the central hub. It receives power from the transformer or main supply and distributes it to secondary boxes. Key components include the main circuit breaker, main leakage protector, voltmeter, and ammeter for centralized monitoring and control of the entire site ().
- Second-Level Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Box):** Located near high-power consumption areas or large equipment, it receives power from the main box and redistributes it to tertiary boxes. It typically contains branch circuit breakers and branch leakage protectors to protect individual circuits ().
- Third-Level Distribution Box (Switch Box):** Positioned close to the electrical equipment, it provides direct power to devices or groups of similar devices. It includes isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors for direct control and protection ().

Installation and Layout

Placement: Distribution boxes should be within 30 meters of the equipment they serve to minimize voltage drop and ensure safety (). Fixed equipment like tower cranes or construction elevators may have dedicated boxes, while temporary facilities can share a box.

Protection: The system follows a two-layer protection strategy, with leakage protection installed at both secondary and tertiary levels to prevent electrical hazards ().

Load Capacity: Each distribution box typically handles 50–150 kW, with the main switch rating determined by the number of downstream boxes and total equipment load ().

Construction Features: First-level boxes often have bottom-in, bottom-out wiring, copper busbars...
