

# Busbar Cable Tray Measurement

- Rung Spacing (for ladder trays):** Affects cable support and heat dissipation; common spacing is 300mm, but wider spacing may be used for large power cables.

Cable tray sizing should consider cable fill ratio, future expansion, and ventilation to prevent overheating. The required width can be calculated using the total cable cross-sectional area divided by the fill ratio and tray height.

Busbars are rigid conductors used for power distribution in switchgear, panels, and rack systems:

- Width and Thickness:** Determined by current rating, voltage, and allowable temperature rise. Typical copper busbars in industrial applications range from 10mm to 50mm thick and 50mm to 200mm wide, depending on load requirements.
- Rack Integration:** In modular rack systems like Open Rack, busbars are designed to fit equipment bays approximately 538mm wide, with vertical busbars connecting multiple shelves and allowing continuous power distribution.
