

Cable tray bend cutting method

Fabricated (Mitered) Bends: Create a 90-degree elbow by making two 45-degree cuts on the tray sides and notching the base. Fold the tray along the notched lines to form the bend, then fasten with bolts or additional supports if needed. This method works for both horizontal and vertical bends, adjusting the cut location depending on the bend orientation.

Best Practices: Always plan bends and cuts according to the installation layout to minimize on-site adjustments. Use manufacturer guidelines for optimal cutting intervals and bend radii to maintain structural integrity. Ensure bends do not create sharp edges inside the tray that could damage cable insulation. By following these methods, cable trays can be safely and efficiently cut and bent to fit complex installation layouts while maint...
