AI Overview

Cable tray support brackets are designed to securely hold cable trays, with specifications defined by load capacity, material, mounting type, and compliance with standards such as DIN EN 61537.

Types of Support Brackets

- Cantilever Brackets:** Extend horizontally from walls or vertical structures to support cable trays. Commonly used for wall-mounted trays and available in lengths from 100 mm to 300 mm for standard trays, with heavy-duty versions up to 900 mm or more for larger loads.
- Pendant or Suspended Brackets:** Hang from ceilings using threaded rods or suspension systems. Typical lengths range from 1200 mm to 1500 mm, often combined with ceiling brackets or spacers for stability.
- Wall-Mounted Brackets:** Fixed directly to walls, sometimes at a 45° angle using bracket adapters. They can be used with or without additional threaded rod suspension depending on load requirements.
- Center Supports:** Used for long tray runs to prevent sagging, often installed at intervals defined by the tray width and load rating.

Material and Finish

- Steel or Stainless Steel:** Most common for industrial applications, providing high mechanical strength.
- Galvanized or Coated Surfaces:** Enhance corrosion resistance in humid or chemically aggressive environments.
- Aluminum:** Lightweight and corrosion-resistant, suitable for less mechanically demanding installations.

Load and Span Considerations

Bracket spacing and tray support must account for maximum permissible cable weight and tray width. Standard support spacing is typically defined by the manufacturer and may vary with tray type (ladder, solid-bottom, or mesh) and load class. Horizontal and vertical changes in tray direction must be supported within 150 mm of joints to maintain structural integrity.
