- Material Thickness:** Thickness affects load capacity and allowable span. Heavy-duty trays often require 2.5mm or more with reinforced side rails.

Modular Installation: Standard lengths allow for easier alignment, support placement, and future expansion.
Compliance: Using standard lengths ensures compatibility with NEC, NEMA, IEC, or local standards, reducing the risk of inspection failures.
Transport and Handling: Shorter sections (3 meters) are easier to transport and maneuver in tight spaces, while longer sections (6 meters) reduce the number of joints and fittings required.
