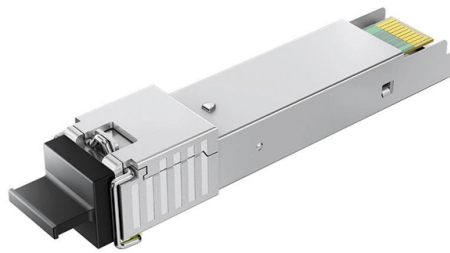

Flex tray connectors: Allow controlled entry of cables from flexible or wire mesh trays into rigid or EMT conduits.
