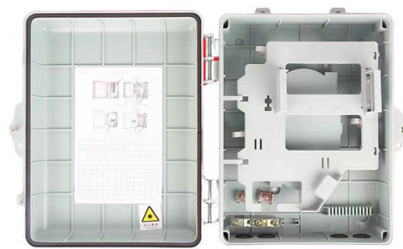


Can a 500-meter single-mode fiber optic cable be used



Overview

A: Yes, but an optical attenuator is required to prevent receiver overloading due to excessive signal power. Single mode fibers are. For example, a fiber optic cable with a distance of 1km supports a bandwidth of 500MHz, while a fiber optic cable with a distance of 2km can only support a bandwidth of 250MHz.
