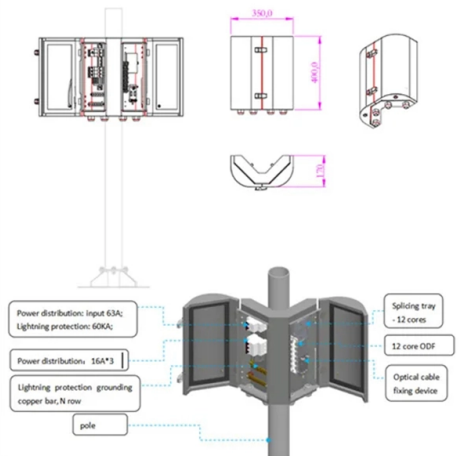

Copper cables provide Power over Ethernet (PoE), which is essential for devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, and Wi-Fi access points . Copper is also more cost-effective for short-distance indoor connections and is easier to terminate and maintain in small office or home...
