Installing Socket Boxes Mark the location on the wall where the socket will be installed. Cut or chisel a hole in the wall to fit the socket box. For concrete walls, use a drill and chisel; for plasterboard, a hole saw is sufficient. Insert the socket box and secure it with screws or plaster, ensuring it is flush with the wall surface. Choose the correct box type: plastic boxes are common for indoor walls, while metal boxes are recommended for wooden structures for fire safety. Wiring the Socket Turn off the main power at the distribution box to prevent electric shock. Run the cable from the distribution box to the socket location, using the appropriate wire gauge for the circuit load. Strip the insulation from the wire ends and connect them to the socket t...
