- Optional: Check Module Identification: Use `show inventory` or `show idprom interface` to verify the module's part number, vendor, and serial number. This ensures compatibility and helps troubleshoot unsupported transceivers.

Tips for Accurate Measurement:

- Ensure fiber connectors are clean and properly seated.
- Avoid using third-party modules that may not report accurate DOM values unless they are pre-coded for Cisco compatibility.
- Regularly monitor Tx/Rx power to detect link degradation, excessive attenuation, or connector issues.
