ITU-T Recommendation L.1203 specifically addresses color and marking identification for DC power distribution in Telecom/ICT installations. It ensures that DC interfaces, cables, and distribution boards are clearly distinguished from AC systems, supporting safe operation and maintenance. Regional and National Standards BS 7671 (UK) and IEC 60364/61439 outline requirements for distribution boards, including color coding, labeling, and accessibility. Key points include: Panels must be clearly labeled with voltage, phase, and polarity information. Main isolators and emergency disconnects must be easily identifiable and accessible. Distribution boxes should be installed in areas free from water, dust, and other hazards, with proper IP protection ratings. RAL color standards are often used for the external coating of distribution boxes to ensure uniform appearance and easy identification in industrial or commercial environments. Common RAL colors for electrical enclosures include light grey (RAL 7035) for general-purpose boxes and other colors for specific functions or safety coding.
