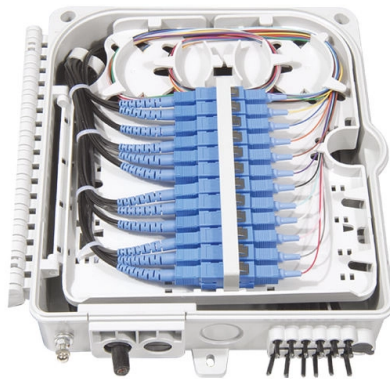


Configuration Requirements for Garden Power Distribution Boxes

Grounding and Safety The metal enclosure, electrical board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded. Connect the protective neutral wire reliably through a terminal board.
