A standard three-level power distribution system consists of a main distribution board, secondary distribution boards, and tertiary distribution boards, ensuring safe and efficient power delivery from the transformer to end-use equipment.

Main Distribution Board The main distribution board serves as the primary hub for the entire electrical system, receiving power from the transformer at 0.4kV after stepping down from high-voltage lines (e.g., 10kV) and distributing it to secondary boards. It does not supply power directly to end-use devices but centralizes control and protection. Key components include isolating switches, circuit breakers, and Residual Current Devices (RCDs) to ensure overall circuit safety and allow for maintenance without disrupting the entire system.

Secondary Distribution Boards Secondary distribution boards act as intermediate hubs, typically serving specific buildings, floors, or large equipment. They distribute three-phase power to motors and heavy loads, using larger capacity circuit breakers for safe operation. These boards often feature dual-door protection, durable coatings, and rainproof designs for outdoor installations. They also implement a two-layer protection strategy, with RCDs at both the secondary and tertiary levels to enhance safety.

Tertiary Distribution Boards The tertiary distribution board is the final junction point, supplying 220V single-phase power directly to home systems or individual devices. Each device is protected independently following the principle of “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box”, which prevents multiple devices from sharing a single protective circuit. Tertiary boards can be fixed or portable, and they ensure the last line of protection for end-use equipment.
