

Configuring Fiber Optic Switch Networking

Multi-mode fiber is generally sufficient for short distances, while single-mode fiber is better for longer runs.

Step 4: Configure Switch Ports Enable the fiber-enabled ports on the switch and configure the speed and duplex settings if required. Assign the ports to the correct VLANs to segment network traffic. For example, you may create a dedicated VLAN for fiber connections to separate them from copper Ethernet traffic.
