- Label and Document** Label each patch cord and port for traceability. Proper documentation helps prevent mis-patching and simplifies future maintenance.

Best Practices Always handle fiber cords gently; avoid pulling or twisting. Do not mix SC/APC and SC/UPC connectors, as incompatible endfaces can damage the link. Use appropriate jacket types (LSZH for indoor, OFNP for plenum, PE for outdoor) based on the installation environment. Maintain organized routing to reduce stress and signal degradation. Following these steps ensures a reliable, low-loss connection between your fiber optic patch cord and switch, supporting high-speed network performance.
