

Connect the fiber optic cable to the router s adapter port

Via ONT (most common): Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical input port. Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN/Ethernet output to the router's WAN port.

Step 4: Power On and Configure

Power on the ONT first (if used) and wait for the status lights to stabilize. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Access the router's admin panel via a browser to enter ISP credentials if required and update firmware for optimal performance.

Step 5: Verify the Connection

Check internet access on a connected device. Run a speed test to confirm fiber speeds are achieved. If the connection fails, reboot the ONT and router or contact your ISP for troubleshooting.

Precautions: Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply to prevent damage. Keep connectors clean and free from dust. Ensure both devices are...
