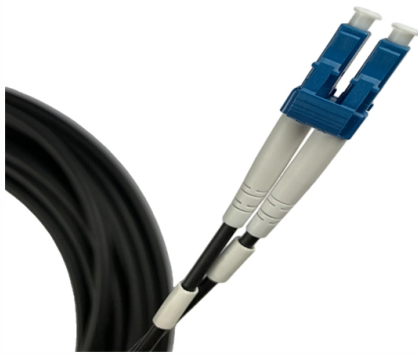

Insert the conduit into the connector. For squeeze-type connectors, tighten the screws to clamp the conduit securely. For compression-style connectors, tighten the nut to compress the gasket against the conduit jacket, creating a moisture-tight seal.

Step 4: Attach to the Distribution Box

Remove the appropriate knockout from the box. Insert the connector through the knockout and secure it from inside the box using a threaded locknut. Ensure the locknut cuts into the metal of the box to establish a low-resistance electrical bond.

Step 5: Install an Insulating Bushing

Slide a bushing onto the connector inside the box to protect wire insulation from sharp edges. This step is critical for preventing chafing and maintaining long-term safety.

Step 6: Pull the Wires

Feed the flexible wire through the conduit into the box carefully, avoiding kinks or sharp bends. Connect the wires to the appropriate terminals in the distribution box according to electrical codes.
