The main bonding jumper (NEC 250. 28) connects the neutral to the ground at the service equipment to provide a fault-return path. It carries the unbalanced load in a 120/240-volt residential system and operates at a potential close to zero volts relative to the earth. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. After the electricity travels through the hot wire and powers an appliance, the neutral conductor provides the path for the unbalanced current to return to the. Attach the neutral (white) conductor to the bonded neutral bus, and the ground (bare or green) to the grounding terminal strip. Ensure continuity by clamping the GEC with.
