

Connection between surge protection box and distribution box



AI Overview

To connect a surge protection device (SPD) to a distribution box, install it close to the panel, connect live, neutral, and protective earth wires through an appropriately rated breaker, and keep wiring short and direct for optimal protection.

Step-by-Step Installation

- 1. Select the Correct SPD Type**

- 4. Wiring Connections**
Connect the SPD to the live (L), neutral (N), and protective earth (PE) terminals. Use short, direct wires (preferably AWG #10 or larger) to reduce resistance and ensure fast surge diversion. Avoid sharp bends and excess wire length; the total conductor length should ideally be less than 0.5 meters and never exceed 1 meter.
- 5. Overcurrent Protection**
Connect the SPD through an appropriately rated MCB or fused disconnect to protect the device and maintain supply continuity in case of SPD failure. Do not rely on the main utility fuse for SPD protection, as it may disconnect the entire supply.
- 6. Final Checks**
Ensure all connections are tight and secure. Replace the distribution board cover and switch on the main breaker. Test the SPD according to the manufacturer's instructions to confirm proper operation.
