This is achieved by using stacking-capable switches which have dedicated ports and use dedicated cables to connect to other switches in the stack. These features are available in all the releases subsequent to the one they were. basically after you have configured the stack, you can manage it as if it were a single device, as you can read from the document, both devices are responsible for traffic forwarding (Data Plane), but only the Master switch manages the control plane You can configure the stack as L2 or L3 device. Switch cascading is a traditional method for connecting multiple Ethernet switches. The major benefits of stacking.
