

Design Requirements for Electrical Distribution Boxes in Yemen s Computer Rooms

Electrical distribution boxes in computer rooms must comply with international safety standards, provide adequate working space, proper grounding, fire protection, and environmental controls to ensure reliable operation.

Room and Structural Requirements

Electrical distribution boxes should be installed in dedicated rooms or closets separate from other building functions to minimize interference and ensure safety . Walls should be constructed from concrete or concrete blocks, with gypsum boards acceptable for smaller distribution closets. Fire resistance of at least 3 hours is recommended for rooms housing transformers with dielectric liquids . Floors must be sealed and waterproofed, with non-skid epoxy coatings preferred, and carpet should be avoided. Vertical conduit penetrations require fireproof sleeves extending above and below the floor slab .

Electrical and Safety Standards

Distribution boxes must adhere to NEC and IEC standards, ensuring safe voltage and current ratings, proper short-circuit protection, and reliable grounding . Key requirements include:

- Voltage rating:** up to 600V for industrial systems; low voltage defined as $\leq 1000V$.
- Short-circuit protection:** circuit breakers or fuses to prevent equipment damage and fire.
- Grounding and earthing:** permanent, continuous paths to protect personnel and equipment, keeping touch voltage below 50V during faults .
- Dead-front panels:** cover live parts to prevent accidental contact, with only handles and indicators accessible .
- Working Space and Access:** Adequate working space around distribution boxes is critical for maintenance and safety . NEC guidelines recommend:
 - Width:** at least equal to equipment width, minimum 30 inches.
 - Depth:** d...
