Fiber optic cable sequential numbers are required at each pole location and vault wall. Sequential numbers will identify conduit length, and slack left in vaults and at poles.

The number of optical fibers in ADSS cables is typically higher than the number of optical fibers in OPGW or WRAP aerial cables. Fiber counts usually vary between 24 to 48 fibers for most long
