MI cables are highly durable and non-combustible, but they are rigid and less flexible than standard tray cables, which can complicate installation in trays.

UL Listing and NEC Compliance: MI cables are not typically listed as tray-rated. Using them in a cable tray may violate NEC 392 requirements unless the manufacturer explicitly certifies the cable for tray installation.

Mechanical Support: MI cables are rigid and may require special supports or clamps to prevent damage in a tray system.

Thermal and Fire Safety: While MI cables excel in high-temperature environments, tray-rated cables are also tested for crush, impact, and exposure ratings, which may differ from MI cable specifications.

Installation Flexibility: MI cables are difficult to bend and route, which can limit their practicality in complex tray layouts.
