5. Component + Pin Number: In complex panels, wire numbers may include the component abbreviation and pin number, e.g., KM1-3 indicates the wire connected to pin 3 of contactor KM1.
6. Location + Function Identification: Some numbering systems include spatial and functional information, e.g., L-S1-M could indicate a wire on the left side (L), related to the start function (S1), connected to a motor (M).

Standardized Electrical Identification

Switchboards and motor control centers (MCCs) are assigned Electrical Identification Numbers, which are used as prefixes for all circuits and wires connected to the equipment. For example, a low-voltage switchboard labeled P410 may have a wire numbered 1201, where "12" refers to the circuit and "01" to the specific wire.
