Capable of being inadvertently touched or approached nearer than a safe distance by a person. It is applied to electrical conductors or circuit parts that are not suitably guarded. In the context of residential and commercial electrical systems, “exposed wiring” refers to conductors that lack the required insulation, are terminated without an approved protective device, or are installed outside of a mandated enclosure or raceway. In contrast, a well-planned wiring structure ensures stable and reliable operation for years. In it's definition, a part is considered exposed if it is not properly guarded, isolated, or insulated.
