ISO/IEC 11801: This standard specifies the generic cabling for customer premises, covering both copper and fiber optic cabling.

Compliance and Testing

Compliance with these standards is crucial for ensuring the quality, reliability, and interoperability of fiber optic networks. Testing standards, such as those from TIA and IEC, provide guidelines for measuring performance parameters like insertion loss and return loss, which are essential for maintaining network integrity.
