- Fiber optic cleaning pens: For quick dry cleaning of connector end faces.
- CLETOP-S or click-clean tools: Provide cost-effective, repeatable cleaning for single or multi-fiber connectors.
- Lint-free wipes and pads: Used with isopropyl alcohol ($\geq 99\%$) for wet cleaning.
- Fiber optic end-face magnifiers or microscopes: To inspect connectors before and after cleaning.
- Dust caps: To protect connectors when not in use.

Cleaning Methods

- Dry Cleaning: Using a cleaning pen or cassette to remove dust. Quick but may leave static charges that attract contaminants.
- Wet-Dry Cleaning: Apply a small amount of isopropyl alcohol to a lint-free pad, wipe the connector, then dry with a clean section of the pad. This method is more effective for oils or stubborn residues.
- Combination Cleaning: Recommended by IEC standards, involves using a solvent with immediate drying to ensure thorough cleaning without static buildup.

Best Practices

- Clean before connect: Always clean and inspect connectors before mating, even if new.
- Inspect after cleaning: Use a microscope or magnifier to confirm the connector is free of contaminants.
- Maintain a clean environment: Avoid high humidity or dusty areas during cleaning.
