General Fixing Method

- Preparation** Inspect the clamp and cable for damage or deformation. Select the correct clamp size to match the cable diameter. Gather necessary tools: torque wrench, hand-guided banding tool, fiber stripper, precision cleaver, and safety equipment.
- Mounting the Bracket** Secure the pole bracket, wall hook, or surface mount firmly to the support structure. Ensure the bracket can handle the cable tension and environmental conditions.
- Installing the Clamp** Open the clamp's wedge or movable section to insert the cable without bending or twisting it. Place the cable carefully into the clamp body, aligning it in the gripping channel. For tension clamps, wrap stainless steel bands around the pole and fasten with buckles using a hand-guided tool.
- Tensioning and Securing** Gently pull the cable to achieve the required tension; the wedge system will grip the cable automatically. Ensure the cable remains aligned and does not exceed the maximum recommended long-term load. Attach the clamp to the bracket or hook securely, checking for stability and vibration resistance.
