Duct Entry and Cable Management Duct entries should be aligned with the junction box ports and may include purpose-designed pockets or sleeves to facilitate cable entry. Backfill around ducts and the foundation should use suitable granular material (e.g., Type 1 or as-dug material) to provide support and prevent movement. Maintain proper spacing and clearance for future cable expansion or maintenance.

Grounding and Bonding For safety and compliance, the junction box foundation should include grounding and bonding provisions. This ensures that any metallic components are electrically connected to the earth, reducing the risk of electrical hazards.
