- Environmental Safeguards:** Outdoor cables are exposed to UV radiation, temperature extremes, moisture, wind, ice, rodents, and accidental digging. Protective jackets, water-blocking materials, and burial in conduits help mitigate these risks.
- Cable Markers and End Caps:** Markers identify cable locations for maintenance, while end caps protect exposed fiber ends from dust, moisture, and physical damage.

Network-Level Protection

Optical Line Protection (OLP): OLP systems safeguard networks against fiber cuts, equipment failures, or signal degradation by automatically switching traffic to a backup path. Two main schemes are used:

- 1:1 Protection:** One primary working path and one reserved backup path. Traffic switches to the backup only when a failure occurs, conserving resources and bandwidth.
- 1+1 Protection:** Traffic is transmitted simultaneously on both working and protection paths. The receiver selects the better-quality signal in real-time, providing instant failover and high reliability, though at higher resource cost.
