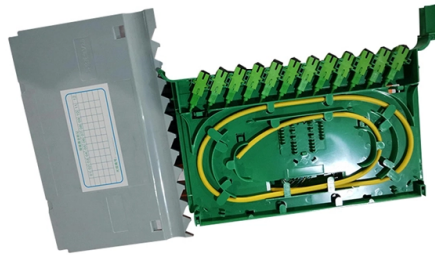


Fiber Optic Connector Fabrication

Fiber optic connectors are fabricated through precise fiber preparation, cleaving, splicing, and assembly into connector housings to ensure low-loss, reliable optical connections.

Fiber Preparation Before connectorization, the optical fiber must be prepared by removing the protective coating and cleaning the bare fiber. This can involve soaking the fiber in acetone to soften the coating for removal, followed by careful cleaning to prevent contamination. Proper fiber preparation ensures that the fiber end is free of debris and ready for cleaving or splicing.

Fiber Cleaving Cleaving is the process of producing a flat, smooth fiber end face. It is typically done by placing the fiber under tension, scribing it with a diamond or carbide blade perpendicular to the fiber axis, and then pulling it apart to create a clean break. Cleaving can be performed manually or with electronic cleavers, including angled cleavers for specialized applications. A high-quality cleave is critical for minimizing insertion loss and back reflections.

Splicing Methods

- Mechanical Splice** Mechanical splicing aligns and mates two fiber ends using a precision sleeve and index-matching fluid to reduce reflections and loss. This method is reusable and often used for temporary connections or in couplers and WDM devices.
- Fusion Splice** Fusion splicing involves physically melting the tips of two fibers together using an electric arc. This creates a permanent, low-loss connection with minimal back reflection, making it ideal for high-performance networks.

Connector Assembly Fiber optic connectors, such as ST, SC, and SMA types, are assembled by fixing the prepared fiber into a ferrule and housing. The ferrule aligns the fiber core with the mating connector, while the housing provides mechanical stability and protection. Some connectors use grooved substrates to hold multiple fibers in place, reducing stress and preventing breakage. Connector assembly may also involve polishing the fiber tip to achieve a mirror-flat or angled surface, depending on the connector type.
