Alignment: Place the fibers in the splicer. Core alignment methods, such as Local Injection and Detection (LID) or profile alignment for ribbon fibers, ensure optimal light transmission. Fusion: The splicer generates an electric arc to melt and fuse the fiber ends. Modern splicers automate this process and measure splice loss in real-time. Protection: Apply a heat-shrink sleeve or clamp-on protector over the splice to shield it from moisture, stress, and environmental damage.
