SPDs used in conjunction with fiber optic systems should be UL1449 listed or compliant with relevant surge standards to ensure proper protection of electrical devices. For installations spanning multiple buildings or exposed to outdoor environments, grounding and bonding practices may be recommended to protect connected electrical equipment, even though the fiber itself remains unaffected. In summary, fiber optic cables themselves do not require SPDs, but any electrical devices connected to the fiber network should be evaluated for surge protection based on risk and local code requirements.
