Splicing Methods and Equipment Fiber optic splicing can be performed using fusion splicing or mechanical splicing. Fusion splicing is preferred for lower light loss and back reflection. Key requirements include: Clean and maintained tools: Cleavers, fusion splicers, and protective sleeves must be properly calibrated and free of contamination. Proper fusion parameters: Set systematically according to fiber type to ensure minimal splice loss. Index of refraction: Use the correct value for the fiber type during OTDR testing to accurately measure splice loss. Testing and Verification After splicing, testing is mandatory to verify continuity and loss: OTDR testing: Measures splice loss and span analysis, often using a 1-km launch reel for pigtail tests to accurately capture connector and splice losses. Optical Power Meter and Laser Light Source: Used to measure power loss at 1310nm and 1550nm wavelengths, with calibration required before testing each span. Trace documentation: All bi-directional and pigtail traces must be saved and submitted for acceptance, following standardized naming conventions. Splice Protection and Closures Spliced fibers must be protected using single or ribbon fiber protection sleeves and splice closures: Sleeves: Typically 40-60mm for single fibers, or speciali...
