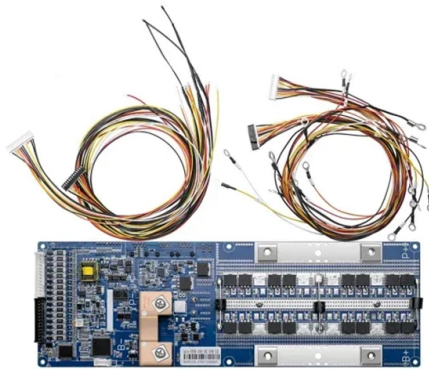


Fiber optic cable to Guyana

Guyana has launched its first direct submarine fibre-optic cable to Bartica, bringing gigabit-speed internet and 5G connectivity to the hinterland. Overview of the Project Guyana recently commissioned a multi-billion-dollar submarine fibre-optic cable connecting Bartica, a key hinterland town, directly to the national fibre-optic backbone operated by ENetworks (ENet). This project marks the first time Bartica has access to coastland-level digital services, including full fibre-to-home gigabit speeds and 5G mobile connectivity. The cable traverses challenging terrain, including the Demerara and Essequibo rivers, and required innovative routing through trails to establish a viable submarine path. Technical and Coverage Details The ENet fibre-optic network now spans seven of Guyana's ten administrative regions, with Bartica becoming a critical hub linking the interior to the coast. The infrastructure supports high-speed internet for homes, businesses, and public institutions, enabling real-time digital services, smart public administration, and enhanced educational and commercial opportunities. The project also introduces 5G mobile service, expanding wireless connectivity in previously underserved areas. Economic and Social Impact The fibre-optic rollout is expected to bridge the digital divide between the coast and hinterland, fostering economic diversification, digital inclusion, and improved public services. Residents and businesses in Bartica can now access the same digital capabilities as those in Georgetown, supporting remote learning, e-commerce, and efficient government services. The initiative aligns with the Government of Guyana's Digital Guyana strategy, which aims to modernize ICT infrastructure and ensure equitable access across all regions.
