

Fiber optic connector plugged directly into the router



Overview

The fiber optic cable does not plug directly into a standard home router because the signal type must be translated. The fiber line terminates at the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which is typically supplied and installed by the internet service provider. Compatible router: Verify that your router supports fiber optic input (look for an SFP or WAN port labeled). SFP stick in router or ONT plugged into Router What's the difference?

I've seen home installations be completed with either a SFP stick plugged into the bottom and the patch lead plugged into that OR a separate ONT SFU box then plugged into the router but this means the client needs to plug sockets. Here is the topic's answer before we get into the details: yes, you can absolutely use a normal router with a fiber optic internet connection. In fact, the overwhelming majority of fiber internet customers around the world do exactly that — they keep using a standard Wi-Fi router they already own. A fiber optic service will require an "ONT" which connects to the fiber cable, and provides an Ethernet port.
