A NO-SPLICE tray is used for pass-through fibers where no splicing occurs, maintaining end-to-end connectivity without altering the fiber path. Typically, lower-numbered trays are reserved for pass-through fibers, while higher-numbered trays are used for splicing operations.

Color and Capacity Codes Some splice boxes use color-coded rows or positions to indicate compatibility and capacity. For example, a row may be coded as:

- No fit (no color): The fiber or cable does not fit in that position
- Partial splice (yellow): Only some fibers can be spliced in that position
- Complete splice capacity (green): The position can accommodate the full fiber count for splicing

These codes help technicians quickly identify which trays or positions can be used for specific fiber types, cable diameters, or splice counts, ensuring proper network planning and installation.

- Cable type compatibility (loose tube vs. ribbon fiber)
- Environmental suitability (indoor vs. outdoor)
- Mounting type (aerial, buried, or rail-mounted)
- Connection method (fusion or mechanical splicing)
