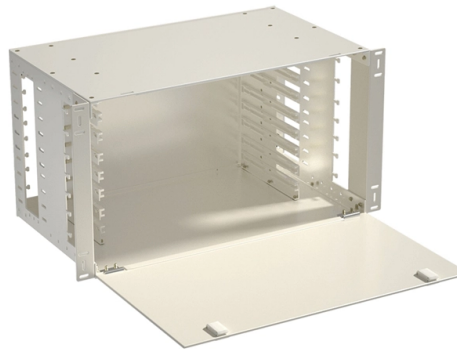


Fiber optic splitter not responding when plugged in

- Check Fiber Orientation and Seating Ensure the fiber is fully inserted, and TX aligns with RX. Verify that the correct jumper type is used and that the transmission distance is within specifications.
- Test the Fiber Link Use a Visual Fault Locator (VFL) or Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS) to check for breaks, microbends, or excessive loss along the fiber.
- Swap Components Replace the splitter, transceiver, or patch cords with known-good units to isolate the faulty component.
