

Grounding flat iron for distribution box connection

To safely ground a flat iron to a distribution box, connect its grounding wire to the PE (protective earth) bar in the box using a properly sized copper wire and secure it firmly. Steps for Proper Grounding

1. Identify the Grounding Point in the Distribution Box Open the distribution box and locate the PE bar or grounding plate, usually marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This is the designated point for all grounding connections in the box .
2. Prepare the Grounding Wire Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting the specifications (typically at least 6 mm² for general applications, or 10 AWG in the US) to ensure low resistance and safety . Strip the insulation at the end of the wire to expose enough copper for a secure connection.
3. Connect the Flat Iron Ground Wire Attach the flat iron's grounding wire to the PE bar using a screw terminal or listed connector. Ensure the connection is tight and free of corrosion. If the flat iron has a grounding plug, you may connect it via a grounding conductor that runs to the PE bar .
4. Ground Other Components if Needed If there are additional electrical components in the distribution box that require grounding, connect them to the same PE bar using separate copper wires. This ensures all equipment shares a common, low-resistance ground path .
5. Verify Continuity and Safety Check that all connections are secure and that the grounding path is continuous. The total ground resistance should be low (typically
