Handling and Installation Guidelines Avoid sharp bends and twists: Maintain the minimum bend radius specified for the cable to prevent fiber breakage or increased attenuation. Pulling techniques: Use proper pulling methods, avoiding excessive tension, twisting, or squeezing. Use lubricants like paraffin if necessary, but avoid soap or abrasive materials. Figure-8 loops: When laying loops on a surface, use figure-8 loops to prevent twisting. Loop size typically ranges from 2-4 meters depending on cable stiffness. Environmental protection: Keep the cable protected from sharp objects, rocks, or edges. If the cable remains outdoors for more than 24 hours during installation, use protective material to prevent damage. Temperature considerations: Respect the maximum installation and storage temperatures for the cable, noting that these apply to the cable itself, not ambient temperature. Connector care: Protect connectors from contamination and scratches to maintain signal integrity. Additional Recommendations Mechanical stress: Minimize pressure at crossing points, especially for armored cables, to avoid localized damage. Attenuation management: Check total cable length and connector losses to maintain the attenu...
