

Has the fiber optic cable in the Democratic Republic of Congo been cut



Overview

A technical failure on the West Africa Cable System (WACS) has caused Internet disruptions in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The measure was announced in a statement from the provincial Ministry of Infrastructure, Public Works, Land Affairs, Urban Planning and Housing in late January. The partnership, first agreed in 2023, is estimated to be worth about \$150 million. The Democratic Republic of Congo is seeking to strengthen its international connectivity infrastructure in response to rising demand for data, driven by the expansion of digital services and the broader digital economy. On June 25, 2026, the government, through the Ministry of Posts, Telecommunications and Digital Technology, signed a memorandum of understanding with Chinese company Genew Technologies for.
