If the height of the electrical equipment is less than 6.5 feet, but when mounted, the top of the equipment exceeds 6.5 feet, the minimum workspace height shall be equal to the height of the equipment.

Safe Clearances for Electrical Equipment: Working Space and

Height clearance: The minimum headroom in front of the equipment is 6½ feet, or the height of the equipment itself, whichever is greater. At no point can this be less than the height of the equipment.
