Practical Considerations Floor-mounted panels should be slightly elevated (5–10 mm) to prevent moisture damage. Ensure the panel is installed away from wet areas, sinks, or locations prone to flooding. The height should allow easy reading of labels and safe operation during emergencies. For high-voltage or low-voltage cabinets, the center of operating handles is generally 1.2–1.5 meters above the floor for ergonomic access.
