Internal Components and Organization

- Circuit Breakers (MCBs, RCBOs, Fuses):** Protect each individual circuit from overloads and short circuits, automatically disconnecting faulty circuits.
- Busbars:** Conductive strips (copper or aluminum) that distribute electricity from the main switch to multiple breakers, reducing wiring complexity and improving reliability.
- Neutral Bar:** Collects all neutral (return) wires from the circuits, completing the electrical path.
- Earth Bar:** Connects all ground wires to the building's grounding system, preventing electric shocks and ensuring safety.
- Main Disconnect Switch:** Allows the entire distribution box to be safely turned off for maintenance or emergencies.
