

How are outdoor fiber optic cables dissolved

- Extreme Temperatures:** Temperatures outside the -40°C to $+85^{\circ}\text{C}$ range can cause the jacket to melt, crack, or lose protective properties, while adhesives may break down, misaligning the fiber core.
- Chemical Exposure:** Strong acids or industrial chemicals can dissolve the PE jacket and etch the glass core, as seen in cases where sulfuric acid damaged underground cables.
- Biological and Physical Damage** Rodents and other wildlife can chew through cables, breaking the protective layers and exposing the core to environmental stress, which accelerates degradation. Physical stress from bending, crushing, or construction activities can also compromise the cable structure.

Disposal Considerations Fiber optic cables are not biodegradable and cannot be "dissolved" safely in the environment. Disposal requires careful handling due to sharp glass fib...
